

## Annual Report 2020-21

### Introduction

The Information, Education & Communication environment in the year of Covid related restrictions was further disrupted since April 2019. At CED, even while social distancing measures like masks, screens, sanitisers, and monitoring of temperature and SO2 levels were followed, the physical centre had to remain closed as public movement and transport were restricted, and CED was able to WFH - work from home. The needed equipment, computers and connectivity was shifted to residences even before the hard lockdown. So, the year has been mainly utilised for consolidating the e-documentation flow, standardising information systems and testing virtual communication

### Ahimsa Conversations

Ahimsa Conversation is a weekly talk with leading personalities on their experience of Ahimsa, and relating that experience to the critical issues facing. They have consistently week after week brought out Ahimsa Conversations which includes voices of those actively working with nonviolence as well as those whose experience in varied fields throws light on its promise and challenges. which society today.

### E-Meets Website

As the lockdown imposed restrictions of travel and physical meeting, organisations started e meetings. CED started a new website called e-meets. This mainly kept track of the coordinates of the different meetings. It also documented the content of presentations and lectures on critical issue at these meetings. We created about 350 posts out of which 139 were events and 70 links to video recordings.
